Domestic abuse accounts for 16% of all violent crime, however it is still the violent crime least likely to be reported to the police.

It is estimated that less than

24% of domestic abuse crime is reported to the police.

Between 2-3 women

are murdered by a current or former partner based on the 12-year average.

We are the largest domestic abuse organisation in Nottingham and one of the largest in the UK. We've been helping women, children, and teens in Nottingham for more than 40 years in Nottingham city Ashfield, Broxtowe, Gedling and Rushcliffe.

THE SUPPORT WE GIVE SAVES LIVES

We have built our services through years of experience and feedback from survivors. They take on a needs-led, strength-based and risk assessed approach in line with domestic violence sector and values supported by Safe Lives and Women's Aid Federation England. These services include:

- Information and support
- Drop-ins and one-to-one support
- Healthy relationship courses and therapeutic groups
- Refuge and emergency accommodation
- Foster care for family pets
- Training for healthcare professionals in domestic abuse awareness

IN 2022-2023 JUNO HAS...

supported 2726 women and 470 children and young people

received 15,884 calls from Nottingham, Notts, E Mids and nationally via the helpline

supported 56 pets into being fostered

supported 615 survivors of domestic abuse through the Juno justic services

At any one time, Juno is helping between 500-600 women

and children every day
